Mathematics Department

This week the Becket Keys
Church of England School
mathematics department gained
a new member of staff: Miss
Joelene Whykes. Miss Whykes
has recently moved back to the
UK from Australia and is looking
forward to becoming part of the
Becket Keys teaching team.

Miss Whykes will be taking on some of classes currently taught by our existing mathematics team and has been working closely with colleagues this week to get to know her new classes.

Students continue to make excellent progress in mathematics and we are delighted with our most recent assessment results which show us that nearly all students in Year 7 and 8 are on track to hit the expected progress targets and around half of all students are exceeding these targets.

We are also very pleased to see so many students attending mathematics club and other mathematics sessions. For example, Mrs Rowan saw around 20 students from Year 8, during the Easter Holiday, for a master class in constructing the equation of a line and gradients.



Mathematics Club get stuck into Sierpiński tetrahedrons

Maths club attendees have been building a series of Sierpińksi tetrahedrons (see photo above).

These are based on the Sierpiński triangle which is a famous fractal named after the Polish mathematician Wacław Sierpiński.

The Sierpiński triangle is constructed from an equilateral triangle by repeated removal of triangular subsets:

Start with an equilateral triangle.

- 2. Subdivide it into four smaller congruent equilateral triangles and remove the central one.
- 3. Repeat step 2 with each of the remaining smaller triangles
