

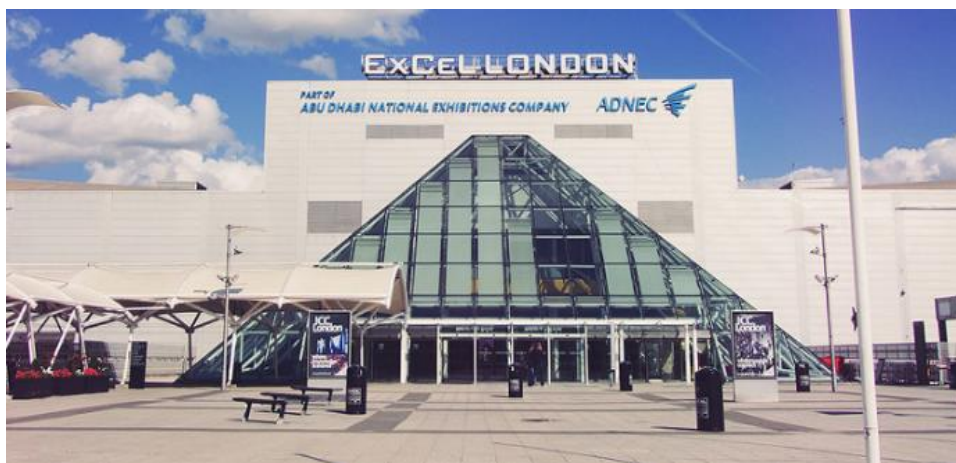

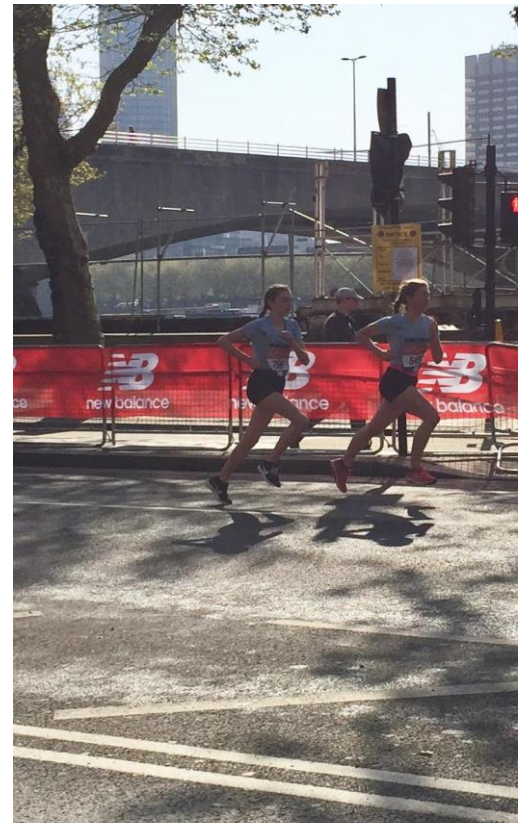
Callum Hayes
